

Meeting 03/03/2022

There has been no further notified flooding within the Tatworth and Forton area.

Swiss Tulle have arranged a company to clear the vegetation on the 17/03/22, and a working party from Swiss Tulle will then clear the overgrown vegetation from the island onto Coombses Pond at a weekend. When this has been completed the company will return to chip it all. Would it be possible for us to arrange volunteers to spread it around the pond and if there is any left over give it to the parishioners for their own use. I feel this would be appropriate as they are supplying the workforce to carry the logs/debris to the Pond Area.

Residents need to be advised they are required to remove everything which is non organic from the island prior to the 17th March as advised by Riparian Officer and their own Riparian Responsibilities.

The area on Swiss Tulle land near their factory will need to wait due to the weather. The old fence has been removed which was thrown onto the Brook Bank and a tree which had fallen.

54/22 A resident in Station Road has raised concerns with regard to the amount of silt , sediment and grit which is coming down from the quarry and blocking the drains again.
