**PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF STOPPING, WAITING, LOADING AND  
UNLOADING, AND ON-STREET PARKING  
SOUTH SOMERSET ORDER 2012  
(AMENDMENT NO.13) ORDER 2019**

Notice is hereby given that the Somerset County Council proposes to make the above Order under Sections 1, 2, 4, 32, 35, 45, 46, 49, 53, and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, (hereinafter referred to as 'the Act of 1984') as amended; and the Traffic Management Act 2004, (hereinafter referred to as 'the Act of 2004') as amended, and all other enabling powers.

The effect will result in changes to the parking and waiting restrictions in the following locations:

**Yeovil:** Preston Grove, Westbourne Grove, Westbourne Close, Crofton Avenue, Watercombe Lane, Brympton Way, Horsey Lane, Malborough Road, Arundel Road, Netherton Road, St John's Road

**Stoke Sub Hamdon:** Hamdon Close, Stonehill

**Chard:** Forton Road, Vicarage Close, Montague Way, Glynswood

**Castle Cary:** Chapel Close, Fore Street

**Crewkerne:** A30 Mount Pleasant

**Currey Rivel:** High Street

**Bruton:** High Street

**Ilminster:** Love Lane, Butts,

**Montacute:** Yeovil Road, South Street, Back Lane, Townsend

**Tatworth and Forton Parish:** B3167 Perry Street, Linkhay, Kent Road

**Templecombe:** High Street, School Lane, Station Road, Yarnbarton, Vine Street
