24/00316/HOU Eden Ridge Burridge Cross Lane Chard Somerset TA20 2TL

What is proposed? Single storey extension to form home office and gym

The Councillors could not see any issues with the application.

24/00228/FUL Land West of Horn Lane Forton Chard Somerset

What is proposed? Demolition of two agricultural buildings

2 agricultural sheds in poor state of repair. It would be an improvement to the area to have them removed.

There could be possible future development into a residential property but a separate application would be needed.

Proposed by Councillor E Peadon, Seconded by Councillor L Mattey. All in favour.

19/24 Chard Junction and the old Creamery, whether the Committee feels it appropriate for the Council to pursue what the plans, if any, are for the buildings in this area of the parish. Councillor Chapple

Councillor Chapple has visited the area and noted that the mobile home storage has disappeared and been replaced by a new sign for container storage area -3 in place.

Yonder Hill – the trees on the left-hand side have been removed. This has not improved the look of the area.

The whole area has a number of dilapidated buildings. Has Somerset Council got any plans for this area?

Other Councillors joined the conversation.

The owners are just sitting on the property. There are no plans that we are aware of. It is difficult to dictate to owners but it is an eyesore. It could be that everyone is waiting for a decision on the Station.

Councillor Down will investigate who the owners are. The Clerk is to send an email to Somerset Councillor Baker.
